

**The MAP laboratory** (CNRS) in partnership with the "**Citadelle of Marseille**" and **ACTA VISTA** (SOS group), with the help of the Heritage Architect in charge of its restoration, invites 12 participants to take over the ramparts, bastions and underground passages of the "Citadelle of Marseille" to discover this singular architectural heritage through digital experimentation. This initiative is backed by the pedagogical components offered by the MAP laboratory at the **École Nationale Supérieure d'Architecture de Marseille**.

**Objectives** Each participant will discover the monument and its restoration challenges through the **presentation of the techniques used and the implementation of traditional know-how.** It will explore in a workshop format a set of digital practices for surveying, analyzing and enhancing the architecture of the fort, **relying on the scientific and technical skills of the MAP laboratory** in charge of the digital data working group of the Notre-Dame de Paris scientific project. Digital resources and materials will be made available to participants to enable them **to design and build visual productions based on data acquired in situ (lasergrametric, photogrammetric surveys, and architectural documentation).**
